2009 Kindergarten Guidance Lessons

Teamwork: “The Circus Act” book:



A mean, competitive spider is determined to win by any means that learns about working together.

Students will gain understanding of school rules, both written and unwritten.
Students identify acceptable ways of behaving and sharing in the classroom.

Friendship: “Star of the Circus: My Little Sister and Me” book and “Butterfly” song
Students describe things about themselves and others.
Students will recognize unique and special qualities in each of us.

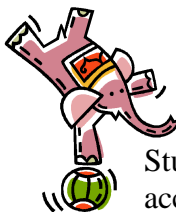


Cooperation: “Hooray for the Circus: A story of Sam the Lamb” book: A story about Sam showing courage, friendship, honesty, and kindness when others are being bullied.



Students will be able to define the term bully and be able to identify who a bully is.
Students will also learn how to make appropriate choices and understand Consequences when inappropriate choices are made.

Teamwork: “Miss Bindergarten Plans a Circus with Kindergarten” book:



A story about an all-animal kindergarten class putting on a circus at school. The animals must learn to work together for the circus to be a success.

Students will recognize the importance of working together as a team to accomplish a goal.



Safety Issues: “No, No the Little Seal” book:

A story about a seal that is a victim of abuse.
No-No’s story is a story about believing in oneself.



Students will learn how to recognize sexual and physical abuse and how to respond appropriately.
