This contract will provide dental services to approximately 400 Head Start/Early Head Start/School Readiness children during the 2005-2006 school year. Services include dental screening and appropriate follow-up sessions. Grant Funds are provided specifically for this purpose.

- 4. Early Intervention Services – Head Start Prenatal to Five-Year-Old Program Crowell

The revised proposals have been prepared for submission to the Federal Administration for Children and Families, Department of Health and Human Services for continued funding of the district’s Early Intervention Services Head Start Prenatal to Five-Year-Old Program. The allocation for the 3-5 year old population is \$5,634,558 and the allocation for the prenatal to three-year-old and expectant mothers population is \$1,121,571.

- 5. Stipulation to Dismissal of Employee Case No. E-0405-11 and Back to Work Agreement Robinson

This case was scheduled for hearing before the Board on August 4, 2005.
