School Improvement Plans for the 2005-2006 school year have been prepared by each School Advisory Council in accordance with School Board Policy 2.42 and Florida Statutes 1001.11.

- 8. Memorandum of Agreement between the School Board and Health Department..... Black

This Memorandum of Agreement provides health services to 12 Alachua County public schools in the form of salary and benefits for 13 registered school nurse specialists. No exchange of funds is required in this agreement.
