- 9. Resolution No. 05-08--District Participation in the Crown Consortium 2005-2006 Shewey

This resolution adopts a plan for cooperating with the School Boards of other districts in an educational consortium, the Crown Consortium, for acquisition of materials, contracted services, and participation in programs, when such meets specific needs of the district and is deemed educationally/monetarily beneficial by the School Board.

10. Contract for Dental Services with ACORN Clinic for the 2005-2006 School Year..... Crowell
- This contract has been prepared between the School Board of Alachua County Head Start/Early Head Start/School Readiness Program and ACORN Clinic to provide dental services to approximately eleven (11) expectant mothers during the 2005-2006 school year.
11. Contract Amendment No. 1—Early Learning Coalition of Alachua County Crowell
- This amendment has been prepared for submission between the School Board of Alachua County and the Early Learning Coalition of Alachua County to reduce the number of students contracted for services.
12. Memorandum of Agreement with Practical Cultural Education Center for Girls (PACE)..... Chambers
- This agreement allows the district's School Food Service program to provide PACE with meals, which meet USDA specifications. PACE will pick up the meals and reimburse the district's School Food Service program as follows: \$1.50/breakfast, \$0.30/reduced breakfast, \$2.25/lunch, and \$0.40/reduced lunch.
13. Memorandum of Agreement with Gainesville Wilderness Institute (GWI) Chambers
- This agreement allows the district's School Food Service program to provide GWI with meals, which meet USDA specifications. GWI will pick up the meals and reimburse the district's School Food Service program as follows: \$1.50/breakfast, \$0.30/reduced breakfast, \$2.25/lunch, and \$0.40/reduced lunch.
14. Approval to Use E-Rate Funds to Purchase Deep Freeze Enterprise Licenses Utley
- The use of E-Rate funds (\$32,310.70) would enable the district to purchase 5000 Deep Freeze Enterprise licenses and maintenance, which would enable district support staff to restore a computer workstation back to a workable state. The Deep Freeze software package makes the restoration a simple task that can be done by the user or remotely by the Help desk.
15. Contract with T3 Technologies Utley
- A contract has been prepared to provide the district with a replacement mainframe TServer within 24-hours in the event that a disaster renders the district's TServer unusable.
16. Incentive Funding for the Update of Interlocal Agreement for Public School Facility Planning Tougaw
- A letter has been prepared to The Florida Department of Community Affairs (DCA) indicating School Board of Alachua County's (SBAC's) interest in and plan for coordinating with Alachua County, and the municipalities within the County, regarding incentive funding for updating of the Interlocal Agreement for Public School Facility Planning by September 1, 2006. It is requested that the Board authorize the Chair to sign and forward the letter to DCA.
