- 6. Amendment to Agreement with the University of Florida College of Medicine, Department of Psychiatry ..... Black

This agreement provides for psychiatric consultations by University of Florida psychiatric clinical faculty, written recommendations to school personnel and referrals for follow-up care to Alachua County Public school students exhibiting high-risk behaviors who otherwise would not be able to receive such services.

- 7. Agreement with the University of Florida, College of Medicine, Department of Pediatrics ..... Black

This agreement provides UF faculty policy recommendation and medical supervision to the Alachua County School Health Program, including physical evaluation and referrals services to needy Alachua County Public school students.

- 8. AmeriCorps—Alachua County Reads! ..... Omer

This is the seventh year for district participation in the AmeriCorps Alachua County Reads! Program. This contract will fund a program manager, eight full-time and nine part-time AmeriCorps members to tutor targeted children in grades K-3.

- 9. Agreement with the Early Learning Coalition of Alachua County ..... Omer

An agreement has been prepared with the Early Learning Coalition of Alachua County to continue the Parent Education Home Visitation Program (PEHCP) to conduct parent education/home visitation to give children at-risk of school failure the best possible start in life and to support parents in their role as their children’s first teachers.

- 10. Boys and Girls Club of Alachua County ..... Omer

A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for Boys and Girls Club mentoring services. The School Board of Alachua County will contract with the Boys and Girls Club of Alachua County to mentor at-risk students during after-school hours at three clubs—Northwest Center, Southeast Center, and Woodland Park. A total of \$49,667 is included in the Florida legislature’s specific appropriation for Alachua County for this purpose.

- 11. Agreement for Services—Dr. Rose Pringle ..... Omer

An agreement for services has been prepared to provide ongoing evaluation services as part of the district’s Math and Science Partnership Grant. Dr. Rose Pringle, Assistant Professor in the School of Teaching and Learning in the University of Florida’s College of Education, will provide this service. Grant funds are designated for this purpose.

- 12. Interlocal Agreement with the City of Gainesville ..... Omer

This agreement will provide for a 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learning Communities Program at Cone Park and Reichert House. Grant funds are provided for this purpose.

- 13. New and Revised Components for the Master In-Service Plan ..... Shewey

The Florida Department of Education requires School Board approval for new and revised components of the district’s Master In-Service Plan. All components in the Master In-Service Plan were revised to reflect new coding requirements from the Department of Education.
