- 8. District Facilities List Gable

- 9. 2005-2006 Classrooms for Kids Program..... Gable

District Certification, Project Allocation List, and Encumbrance Authorization as required for participation in the 2005-2006 Classrooms for Kids Program.

- 10. Certificate of Final Inspection for Project SBAC C0230—Alachua Elementary School Parking and Traffic Safety Improvements..... Gable

This project has been inspected by the project architect and facilities department staff. It is requested that the School Board authorize final payment to the contractor upon total acceptance of this project. Final contract amount is \$217,906.70.

- 11. Multi-District Cooperative Agreement for Programs for Deaf/Hard of Hearing for Columbia, Gilchrist, Hamilton, and Levy Counties Black

This agreement provides for ESE services to students of the above counties in the Deaf/Hard of Hearing Program within grade levels PK-5 at Lake Forest Elementary School. The agreement is effective July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2006, and the cost to each county is \$3,200 for each student.

- 12. Amended Cooperative Agreement with the Department of Juvenile Justice..... Hall

This agreement provides educational programs for eligible students at North Florida Juvenile Detention Center and Alachua Halfway House for Girls.

- 13. Amended Agreement with Alachua County Child Care Resources, Inc. Hall

This agreement provides childcare services to infants for parents that are enrolled in the teen program.

14. Interlocal Agreement with the City of Gainesville and Alachua County Edwards

This agreement with the City and County provides for financing and management of mentoring services for students in the Academy of Innovative Business Ownership.

15. Contractual Agreement with Bertram Hughes, D.M.D. Crowell

A contract has been prepared with Bertram Hughes, D.M.D., to provide dental services to approximately 500 Head Start/Early Head Start/School Readiness children during the 2005-06 school year.

16. Contract with ACORN Clinic Crowell

A contract has been prepared with the ACORN Clinic to provide dental services to approximately 70 Head Start/Early Head Start/School Readiness children during the 2005-2006 school year.
