7. School Improvement Guide 2005-2006..... Anusavice

The School Improvement Guide will assist schools in developing School Improvement Plans. It is also designed to provide School Advisory Councils with technical assistance and guidance.

8. Boys and Girls Club of Alachua County..... Omer
- A proposal has been approved by the Florida Department of Education for Boys and Girls Club Mentoring Services. The School Board of Alachua County will contract with the Boys and Girls Club of Alachua County to mentor at-risk students during after-school hours at three clubs: North West Center, South East Center, and Woodland Park. A total of \$49,667 is included in Florida Legislature’s Specific Appropriation for Alachua County for this purpose.
9. Subcontract with University of Florida ..... Omer
- The University of Florida has been awarded a grant from the National Science Foundation. A modification of an agreement has been prepared with the University of Florida to conduct activities related to an education project entitled “Science Partners in Inquiry-based Collaborative Education (SPICE). Under the terms of the agreement, funds in the amount of \$47,000 will be provided to the school system to employ a Teacher Specialist to coordinate program activities.
10. Technical Assistance Grant for the Early Completion of the Update to the Public Schools Interlocal Agreement ..... Tougaw
- This subgrant agreement with the Department of Community Affairs provides \$18,603.12 for the early update of the Public Schools Interlocal Agreement per Senate Bill 360.
11. Professional Services ..... Gable
- a. Professional Services Fees for Project SBAC A0504—Westwood Middle School Classrooms Renovation, Building 1
- On February 5, 2002, the Board approved Craig Salley & Associates, Architects, Gainesville, Florida, as the design professional for the above-referenced project. It is requested that the Board approve a negotiated fee of 7.7% of the construction cost for professional services on this project.
- b. Professional Services Fees for Project SBAC A0505—Loften High School New Classroom and Multipurpose Building
- On May 21, 2002, the Board approved Long & Associates, Inc., Tampa, Florida, as the design professional for the above-referenced project. It is requested that the Board approve a negotiated fee of 6.9% of the construction cost for professional services on this project.
