**Purpose and Explanation:** A proposal has been prepared for submission to the Florida Department of Education for the Title I, Part C Migrant Education Program. This program helps state and local education agencies to remove barriers to school enrollment, attendance, and academic achievement for children of migrant workers so that they have access to the same appropriate public education, including preschool education, provided to other children.

The Alachua Multi-County Migrant Education Program serves as the host for 14 surrounding districts in the north Florida area. These counties include Alachua, Baker, Bradford, Citrus, Clay, Columbia, Dixie, Duval, Flagler, Gilchrist, Levy, Nassau, St. Johns, and Union.

A total of \$83,768.00 is requested. Funds are requested for the continuation of services during the summer to needy migrant children and youth.
